Text of the Articles of Incorporation
THE ORTHODOX CHURCH OF THE ALL SORROW GLADNESS in Mays Landing,
New Jersey

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that we, IRENEY BEKISH, JAKOB SOKOL, DIMITRO JURKOVSKIJ, KARP STAR, LEONID GAJEVSKI, IVAN MOSEV and IVAN HOLYK, the undersigned being members of an unincorporated Russian Orthodox Greek Catholic Church in the State of New Jersey, do hereby associate ourselves into a corporation under and by virtue of the provisions of an Act of the Legislature of the State of New Jersey entitled "An Act Concerning the incorporation and management of congregations or parishes of the Russian Orthodox Greek Catholic Church of North America, and supplementing title 16 of the Revised Statutes" and further known as Chapter 139 of the Laws of 1945, and further known as N. J. S. 16:15A - et seq., the amendments and supplements thereto, for a lawful purpose other than pecuniary profit as hereinafter stated and to that end we do by this instrument certify that:

FIRST: The name by which this religious corporation shall be known in law shall be The Orthodox Church of The All Sorrow Gladness.

SECOND: The purposes for which this religious corporation is formed are to receive, hold, care for, invest in and operate real and personal property, and to use and distribute from time to time all income and all principal, as well, which it shall receive in charitable gifts to be applied, consistently with

the existing laws, for the benefit of an indefinite number of persons, either by bringing their minds or hearts under the influence of religion, and religious education, and more specifically in accordance with the teachings, doctrine, discipline, worship, Holy Tradition the Seven Ecumenical Councils and the Holy Fathers, and as kept by the Orthodox Churches of the East and further in accordance with the statutes or rules heretofore or hereafter adopted by a general convention (Sobor) of the Russian Orthodox Greek Catholic Church of America, metropolitan council, having its main office currently at 59 East Second Street, New York City, New York and the Russian Orthodox Greek Catholic Faith, historically referred to as the Eastern Catholic Confession or Eastern Orthodox Church.

It is the intent and purpose that the said corporation shall be organized and operated exclusively for religious, religious education and charitable purposes within the classification of legal charities, and no part of the net earnings or of the principal shall inure to the benefit of any private person, or parishioner, and no substantial part of the activities of such corporation, or of any recipient of its funds, shall be to carry on propaganda or otherwise attempt to influence legislation.

THIRD: Said corporation shall be located and its activities shall be conducted in the Township of Hamilton, County of Atlantic and State of New Jersey.

FOURTH: (a) The number of Trustees selected for

Orthodox Greek Catholic Church of North America and five of whom shall be lay members and parishioners in good standing of the said corporation; the names and post office addresses of said Trustees are as follows:

4. Karp Star, R. F. D. #1, East Weymouth Road, Vineland, N. J.
5. Leonid Gajevski, 130 Pennington Avenue, Mays Landing, N. J.
6. Ivan Nosev, 12 Hudson Street, Mays Landing, N. J.
7. Ivan Holyk, 44 West Main Street, Mays Landing, N. J.

(b) ~~Two of the Trustees selected from members of~~ the Clergy as above set forth in the second and succeeding years of the existence of the said corporation shall be the Metropolitan-Archbishop of the Russian Orthodox Greek Catholic Church of North America and Rector of the said corporation.

FIFTH: The name and post office address of the registered agent of said corporation upon whom process against this corporation may be served is Jakob Sokol, 12 Old Egg Harbor Road, Mays Landing, New Jersey.

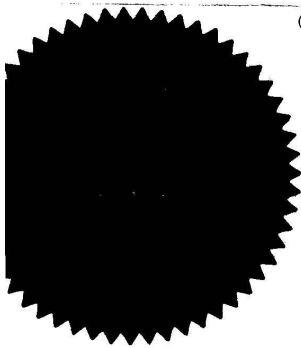
